Dear Senator Graham:

The Department of Interior is evicting Stiltsville December 1, 2000, notwithstanding misleading press releases to the contrary. The Park's current proposal is not real and is not acceptable.

What is badly needed is for you to immediately express your support for House Bill 3033 (park boundary adjustment) and propose similar legislation in the Senate to remove Stiltsville from the northern extreme boundary of Biscayne National Park and return it to Florida in exchange for equal submerged state land, as Florida has requested.

Or, please immediately press for another extension of the current leases (2 years or so), so further evaluation can be performed. Please do not forget the people of Florida, or ignore this important issue. Stiltsville and South Florida need your help.
